School Colors: Green (Hunter) and Gold

School Spirit Day: On Fridays, students and staff are encouraged to wear either a school Spirit T-shirt or school colors.

School Dress Code: The school has a uniform policy.

The uniform is as follows:

Any solid color collared style polo's (Golden Grove's logo preferred) that are paired with khaki, navy, blue jean pants, shorts (fingertip length), jumpers, skirts, or skorts. Jeans should be worn in good taste (not frayed or torn and with no decorations).

Leggings are permitted, however, they must follow above solid colors for pants. Students must wear shorts or skirts over leggings. Golden Grove T-shirts will be reserved for School Spirit Day on Fridays. Jackets and other outer garments for school must be a solid color and follow dress code. Students are permitted to wear only (logo free) solid, school colored jackets and sweaters inside the building since it is climate controlled). Thong-type shoes (flip-flops), cleats, sneaker with wheels and high heels should not be worn as they are dangerous during outdoor play.

Closed toe shoes only. Shoes must have backs.


